1. Enter "Ford" software and choose "Auto Search" .



2. Confirm the vehicle specification, and choose "Yes" .



3. Select "Module Programming" .



4. Select "Programmable Module Installation" .



5. Select "AWD(All Wheel Drive)" .



6. Whether the original mode still available? If we have removed it, please select "No" .



7. Read the tips carefully, select “manual” when we have replaced by a new module or original module not available.







- Set ignition switch to OFF (position 0).



10. Input the VIN.



11. Confirm the VIN right or not.



12. Install a new module in vehicle.



13. Turn on ignition.






